Re: Lurching of Electronic Cargo Tracking Certification & Customs Automation

With reference to the subject, I would like to extend to you on behalf of the National Revenue Authority my greetings.

Following an Authenticated Contract dated 24th, February and witnessed by Ministry of Justice & Constitutional Affairs and signed by the Ministry of Trade and Industry, Ministry of Finance and Planning (National Revenue Authority), Ministry of Investment and K-Polygone Multinational in an effort to support, enhance & increase governments revenue collection and keep the statistical records of all goods entering in and out the region of South Sudan, this Circular Letter establishes a new policy of the Government of South Sudan for the implementation of Customs automation with the Electronic Cargo Tracking Note (ECTN).


This Circular Letter serve to inform and mandate all Government functions/offices at all South Sudan Border Entry Points to take all necessary actions aimed at strengthening the compulsory nature of the agreement during customs clearance in particular the Electronic cargo Tracking Certification in accordance with the inter-ministerial circular No. (6) RSS/MT&I/J/18/12/2020, directing the adherence to compulsory subscription of the Electronic Cargo Tracking Note (ECTN) and Freight Commission Certificate (FCC) effective immediately.

The longstanding policy of the Government of South Sudan has been to secure an efficient measure to encounter malpractices in our revenue collecting regime and to ensure that all cargo (import/export) and transit of goods shipped in containers or in bulk by road, air and maritime transport entering the South Sudanese Border Entry points must be covered by the ECTN and FCC documents issued by K-POLY-GONE at all loading points. In accordance with this circular, all clearing and forwarding agencies are mandated and urged to work

closely with K-POLYGONE to ensure that no goods shall be cleared unless they are covered by ECTN and FCC certificates or else otherwise they shall be charged with fine fee and demurrage fee.

I request all your support to K-POLYGONE and ALL his local agent team.
